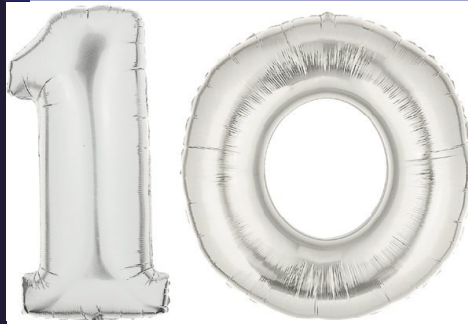
We have achieved the CHAS Accredited Status for a second year, which means we are fully compliant with all Health & Safety regulations and have the necessary systems in place.

On the 5th of June 2008 Fieldcrown turned the 10-year milestone - doesn't time fly!

Many of the staff and site operatives have been with Fieldcrown from the start and developed their roles consistently through the years. Jon Grant (currently Site Manager at King's Place, King's Cross), was Fieldcrown's very first employee, starting out as a Bricklayer.

Fieldcrown was initially formed as a premium brickwork contractor back in June 1998 by Rene Hawkins (Director of the Group and Managing Director of Fieldcrown Construction) on his return to the UK after running a successful brickwork contracting company in Germany. The initial business plan was to create a company that could provide the construction industry with a brick/blockwork contractor, giving a high level of quality and service to ensure repeat business from it's clients. As the group of companies has grown; £0.5m in the first year to £10.5m in 2008; it has proven that the company's ethos has been proved correct. Fieldcrown has grown and developed into a dedicated Group of Companies, providing quality services across three divisions, Construction, Access and Special Works.

Fieldcrown Construction have successfully completed over 350 projects which include airports, sports facilities, HMP Prisons and MOD centres, to name but a few!

tonnes of scaffolding materials on site.
